JOB DESCRIPTION FOR GAME SCOUTS

Introduction:

The Grumeti Fund is a non-profit organization carrying out wildlife conservation and community development work in the western corridor of the Serengeti ecosystem in Tanzania. Our vision is a world in which people and wildlife live together sustainably, forever. The mission of the Grumeti Fund is to collaboratively contribute to the conservation of the Serengeti ecosystem and the upliftment of local communities. In partnership with the Tanzanian Government and other key stakeholders, we promote conservation best practice and knowledge sharing to optimize impact.

Key Responsibilities:

- To conduct patrol in the conservation areas in efforts to ensure it is safe for wildlife
- To prevent any illegal activities within the Protected area, such as poaching, illegal logging and illegal trespassing
- To affect the arrest of poachers in and outside the protected area when required to do so
- To assist in safeguarding the lives of the people, crops and livestock living near protected area, who might be attacked by wild animals (Human Wildlife Conflict)
- To be prepared to work long hours, day, and night, in austere conditions
- To perform any reasonable activity or duties as directed by the Management.

Qualifications:

Pasiansi certificate qualification or equivalent is highly preferred. Candidates with JKT experience are also encouraged to apply. We are open to considering candidates without these qualifications if they align with our organization's ethos.

- **Age Range:** 20 to 35 years old.
- **Physical Fitness:** Candidates must be physically fit and capable of handling strenuous training and operational scenarios.
- **Educational Level:** O-level certificate (form Four), and well spoken
- **Identification:** Must have a valid national ID.
- **Location:** Preference will be given to candidates residing near the protected area.
